- Experience and skills in electronic/electrical/mechanical/hydraulics
- Nominally 180 days as a Senior Pilot Technician with completed assessments

- Completed competencies as Senior Pilot Tech
- Completed leadership and personal development training
- Holds a current valid offshore medical certificate
- Holds a current certificate in an offshore survival course suitable for geographical area of work
- Must pass pre-employment physical, drug screen and background check
- Subject to random drug screening throughout employment
- Shall be capable of passing HUET/BOSIET certifications

Job Description

- This position is expected to maintain a professional appearance and disposition at all times and exhibit professional courtesy whenever dealing with co-workers and/or other persons involved with job project.
- Assist ROV Superintendents to determine field solutions and resolve project barriers.
- Adhere to all C-Innovation's policies and procedures.
- Foster a professional and safe work environment.
- Maintain, repair and troubleshoot ROV systems.
- Observe safe working practices and adhere to mechanical/electrical principles to industry standards.
- Work independently or as a member of a team.
- Carry out assigned administrative duties in a timely manner.

- Piloting, navigation and log keeping.
- Perform routine and preventative maintenance, troubleshoot and give input to field solutions.
- Establish priorities and accomplish objectives.
- Read and generate schematics, and perform other related duties as required.
- The ROV Supervisor should strive to learn new technical and operational issues everyday on the job.
- Foster the mentoring of ROV technician's in the field.
- The ROV Supervisor will report to the ROV Superintendent while on board the installation or report to the Operations Manager, Operations Coordinator and/or Personnel Logistics Department while onshore.
- Be capable of launch and recovery of ROV system.
- Perform safe operating parameters for the handling system.
- Ensure that the ROV is checked before and after the dive in accordance with relevant pre and post dive check lists.
- Follow lock out, tag out procedures in accordance with C-Innovation policies.
- Perform system weekly and monthly maintenance.
- Maintain a clean and presentable workspace.
- Be adequate in experience of the work.
- Be adequate in understanding of the system to be worked on and practical experience of that class of system.
- Be understanding of the hazards that may arise during the work and the precautions which need to be taken.
- Have the ability to recognize at all times whether it is safe for work to continue.
- Understand and operate within the established company HSE policies and operating standards.
- Operate ROV system as directed by system Superintendent.
- Be familiar with all relevant task procedures, ensuring operations and data recording are carried out correctly.
- Carry out planned maintenance and repairs on ROV and associated equipment as required by C-Innovation.
- Be willing to work offshore in harsh weather environments on a rotation or call-out basis.
- Repair, maintenance and operation of the ROV umbilical cable handling system (winch and hydraulic power unit).
- Repair, maintenance of the ROV hydraulic and mechanical systems.
- Maintain the mechanical spares shipboard inventory.
- Awareness of legislation/guidance, e.g. reporting accidents and managing safety of team on night shifts.
- Commitment to safety by setting an example on safety issues and demonstrating safety leadership to subordinates and work colleagues.
- Communication of safety information to team members when needed.
- Effective use of company safety management system.
- Knowledge of emergency procedures.
- Management of team members during an emergency.
- Knowledge of the ROV team member's roles and responsibilities.
- Communicates effectively with other team members.
- Can identify hazards likely to arise during maintenance activity.

- Coordinate the upkeep of the ROV system planned maintenance schedules.
- Demonstrates ability of fault finding and general maintenance of ROV control and navigation systems.
- Capable of assessing weather conditions and operational parameters for safe ROV operations.
- Capable of navigating ROV to work site in most conditions.
- Can perform all general manipulator duties.
- Can carry out electrical and mechanical umbilical terminations.
- Capable of undertaking trade specialist tasks.
- Ability to coordinate dive records, video logs and audio dubbing.
- Familiarity with correct use of company format for report writing.
- Proven writing skills.
- Capable of pro-active involvement with projected work scopes to meet client requirements.
- Thorough understanding of underwater operations and equipment.
- Training/assessing of Pilot Tech grades I, II, and Senior Pilot Tech
- Organizing and managing the offshore operations team members.
